- 1. Basic Canine Companion Training or Puppy Manners Introduction (\$120*)**
 - ❖ In class, "sit," "down," "stand," "come," "stay," walking on lead without pulling, socialization, jumping up prevention, confidence building exercises, handling/grooming exercises, appropriate play/games, house training, mouthiness, proper pet manners & "off" (impulse control) are discussed and taught
 - ❖ For puppies or adult dogs; Generally 6-12 dogs per class; A class for beginners
- 2. Continuing Training Class (\$120*)**
 - ❖ A Level 2 class building on skills taught in previous classes while teaching more challenging impulse control exercises
 - ❖ Work on having a great canine companion!
 - ❖ For dogs & puppies that have completed Level 1; Generally 6-12 dogs per class
- 3. Intermediate CGC Class (\$120*)**
 - ❖ Achieve owning a phenomenal canine companion while working towards an AKC Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate in Level 3
 - ❖ For dogs & puppies that have completed Level 2; Generally 6-12 dogs per class
- 4. Rally-Obedience Class (\$120*)**
 - ❖ Have fun training your dog in obedience sequences while working on your dog handling!
 - ❖ For dogs that have completed Level 3 & earned a CGC certificate; Generally 4-6 dogs per class
- 5. Agility Class (\$120*)**
 - ❖ Enjoy training your dog on obstacles while building confidence in your off-lead training!
 - ❖ For dogs that have completed Level 4 & earned a CGC certificate; Generally 4-6 dogs per class
- 6. Sniffer Scavenger Dog Class (\$120*)**
 - ❖ A unique class training your dog in tracking and scent work...scavenger style!
 - ❖ For dogs that have completed Level 4 & earned a CGC certificate; Generally 4-6 dogs per class

8. Hourly Individual Lessons at a Training Venue (\$75/per hour*)

Lisa was the first Certified Professional Dog Trainer – Knowledge Assessed (CPDT-KA) in the state of Illinois, has become one of the first in the USA to earn the Certified Behavior Consultant Canine – Knowledge Assessed (CBCC-KA) & Certified Professional Dog Trainer – Knowledge & Skills Assessed (CPDT-KSA) credentials, is one of only a few (in the US) Accredited Pet Behavior Counselors of the Pet Behavior Institute of the United Kingdom, and she strives to enrich her education in canine behavior through hosting & attending continuing education seminars every year. Lisa assisted world renowned canine behaviourist John Rogerson on the first 21 day international dog training/behavior course at Canines Can Care Dog Training Centre, Kusr, Pune District, India; is a Professional Member of the Association of Pet Dog Trainers (APDT), an American Kennel Club (AKC) Canine Good Citizen (CGC) Evaluator, an exam committee member for the Certification Council for Professional Dog Trainers (CCPDT), chair of the Public Education Committee (PEC) of the Akita Club of America (ACA), the Co-Founder of Midwest Akita Rescue Society (MARS), was a Certified Delta Society Pet Partner with her Rescue Akita "Tess" (an animal-assisted activity & animal-assisted therapy dog), & qualified for the silver level at the first ever USA Rally Working Trials (RWT) competition with her SiberCaan Dog "June". Lisa also presented her research, "Utilizing the Companion Sniffer Dog Training Method to Develop Aptitude in Locating Target Scents" (poster session) at the 2010 APDT Annual Educational Conference in Atlanta, GA. Additionally, she recently shared her new work, "An Evidence-Based Canine Companion Training Curriculum Assessment Methodology" in the "Meet the Experts" scientific track at the 2011 APDT Conference in San Diego, CA.
